

# PETITION

TO the National Assembly of Quebec

These are the reasons for this petition:

**WHEREAS** the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada [TRC] spent six years hearing from thousands of former students of residential schools about these institutions that sought to “kill the Indian in the child”;

**WHEREAS** the TRC calls upon “the federal, provincial, and territorial governments, in consultation and collaboration with Survivors, Aboriginal peoples, and educators, to make age-appropriate curriculum on residential schools, Treaties, and Aboriginal peoples’ historical and contemporary contributions to Canada a mandatory education requirement for [all elementary and high school students]” [CA 62.1], and;

**WHEREAS** on July 15, 2015, Canada's premiers indicated their support for all 94 Truth and Reconciliation Commission Calls to Action and said they would implement them in their own provinces.

**We, the citizens of Quebec, petition the National Assembly of Quebec to urge the Government of Quebec to fully implement such a curriculum for kindergarten through grade 11.**
