WHEREAS on July 15, 2015, Canada's premiers indicated their support for all 94 Truth and Reconciliation Commission Calls to Action and said they would act on them in their own provinces and territories.

We, in the prayer that reads as follows, respectfully request that the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan urge the Government of Saskatchewan to fully implement such a curriculum for kindergarten through Grade 12.
